Emergency Procedures

Medical & Accident

1. It is the responsibility of the renting group to provide all emergency and medical care to participants. The number for **Emergency Service** is “911”. The nearest 24 hour emergency room is located at Bethesda Medical Center at Arrow Springs – 100 Arrow Springs Blvd., Lebanon, OH 45036. Phone - 513.282.7000 (See Driving Directions in leader Welcome Packet)
2. The camp host should be notified immediately of accidents or injuries requiring medical attention.
3. If a fatality has occurred, the camp official will notify the Camp Director, who will notify the Divisional Commander and the authorities.

Storms

The camp host will regularly monitor weather conditions during rental periods when severe weather is forecasted. The group leader will be notified immediately by the camp host if a severe storm watch is posted and will be given instructions on how to proceed.

Other Emergencies

In the event of fires or lost campers, the camp will utilize an emergency response system call “Codes”. Codes are announced over the public address system or by repeated single blasts of an air horn. In the event of a Code, all campers and leaders should immediately report to their cabins where an adult leader should account for all participants. The group leader should report immediately to the camp office for further instructions. In the event cabins are unavailable, all participants should report to the dining hall.

Fires

1. Evacuate area of fire quickly!
2. Report fire to the camp host immediately. Camp administration will coordinate the handling of any fire emergency.
3. The “Group Leader” should contact the camp host as soon as possible for further directions.

Lost Campers

1. An adult should contact the camp host as soon as a camper is thought to be missing.
2. A Code signal will be announced over the public address system.
3. The “Group Leader” should meet at the office with camp administration as soon as possible.
4. Camp Administration will give leadership the procedures to take regarding the emergency at hand.

IMPORTANT! Members of a user group are not permitted to issue statements on emergencies to the public! The Camp Director will issue statements to the public under the direction of the Divisional Commander.
