

Summer 2010 Staff Positions

Looking to make a difference this summer? Why not come be a part of a ministry committed to sharing with kids the **HOPE** found only through Christ! Below is a brief overview of the positions we are seeking to fill. More detailed job information is available on each of the specific job descriptions.

PROGRAM STAFF POSITIONS:

Please Note: All Program Staff will assist with the planning and implementation of camp programs under the direction of the Program Director. Also, all program area heads will be responsible to prepare lesson plans for their respective areas.

Chief Counselor/Asst. Program Director:

- Preferred 21 years of age or older.
- General responsibilities include supervision of counselors, planning evening activities, and camper discipline problems.

Nature Counselor:

- Preferred 21 years of age or older.
- Responsible for nature programs including the Nature Center, the Children's Farm, hikes, outdoor adventure, etc...

Ropes Course & Assistant Ropes Counselors:

- Preferred 21 years of age or older.
- Directs all activities at the Ropes Course and Climbing Tower.

Recreation Counselor:

- Preferred 21 years of age or older.
- Responsible for all recreation activities at ball fields, basketball & volleyball courts, etc...

Arts & Crafts Counselor:

- Preferred 21 years of age or older.
- Responsible for all arts and crafts activities.

Equestrian Counselor:

- Preferred 21 years of age or older.
- Responsible for all horse activities, general care, and maintenance of the horses.

Waterfront Director/Head Lifeguard:

- Must be 21 years of age or older.
- Must have CPR and life guarding certifications. WSI preferred.

- Responsible for all aquatic activities including swim lessons, boating, free swim, etc... Also responsible for general maintenance & cleaning of the pool.

Lifeguards:

- Must be 16 years of age or older.
- Must have CPR & life guarding certifications.
- Responsible to be on duty for all aquatic activities and anything assigned by the Waterfront Director.

COUNSELING STAFF POSITIONS:

Senior Counselors:

- Must be 18 years of age or older. Preferred 20 yrs. of age or older.
- Responsible for providing leadership to and overseeing a cabin of fourteen to twenty campers and 2-3 other counseling team members.

Counselors:

- Must be 18 years of age or older.
- Responsible for the day to day supervision of, care for, and leadership of a group of fourteen to twenty campers assigned to your cabin

Junior Counselors:

- Must be 16 years of age or older.
- Responsible for general care of assigned campers and anything else appointed by the Senior Counselor.

SUPPORT STAFF POSITIONS:

Food Service Supervisor:

- Must be 21 years of age or older.
- Responsible for supervision of Dining Room Staff and Kitchen Utility Staff. Provides general supervision of all meals and clean up.

Dining Room Staff:

- Must be 14 years of age or older. Preferred 15 years of age or older.
- Duties include cleaning the dining room after meals, serving from the serving line, and taking care of the needs of campers during meals.

Kitchen Utility Staff:

- Must be 14 years of age or older. Preferred 15 yrs. of age or older.
- Duties include washing dishes, pots & pans, mopping kitchen floors, taking out garbage, etc...

Camp Nurse:

- Must be a RN and over 21 years of age.
- Responsible for the general health and safety of campers and staff, dispensing medicine, band-aids, etc...

Assistant Camp Nurse:

- LPN or RN preferred and over 21 years of age.
- Responsible for all duties assigned under the supervision of the Camp Nurse.

Office Assistant/Canteen Director:

- Preferred 18 years of age or older.
- Responsible for general office work such as answering phones, typing, etc...
- Responsible for all assigned canteen hours, ordering of supplies, and staff free time activities.

Camp Housekeeper/Laundress:

- Preferred 18 years of age or older.
- Responsible for general cleaning of meeting areas, bathrooms, some staff laundry, etc...

Maintenance Staff:

- Must be 16 years of age or older.
- Duties include general maintenance as assigned by Camp Caretaker, including mowing, garbage runs, general repairs, etc...

Staff Kid Counselor:

- Must be 14 years of age or older.
- Counselor for children of staff members.
